OB RISK MITIGATION STRATEGIES

Follow National/State perinatal requirements to reduce the MMR.

- Federal Government-Surgeon General/White House
- New CMS: OB QI Measures—Option for hospital reimbursement
- The Joint Commission (TJC)/IHI

Adopt strategies to reduce racial and ethnic health care disparities.

- Provide or assist with resources to the underserved obstetric population to improve outcomes.
- Assess for inequities, then perform quality improvement strategies to assure diversity, equity, and Inclusion of all pregnant women.
- Be community advocates for improving access to prenatal care.

Participate in your state and hospital Perinatal Initiative program.

- Define areas of obstetric high-risk.
- Design a multidisciplinary plan that includes measures to reduce the MMR of the obstetric population you and your facility serve.

Identify top areas of obstetric risk exposure and fill gaps with education and training.

- Discover the top three areas from MPLA data (cognition, performance, communication, professionalism, system).
- Use education and training resources that assess and fills individual knowledge and skill gaps of all Perinatal providers (MD, RN, Resident, CNM).
- Incorporate simulation into the training of high-risk OB scenarios that increase the MMR (hypertension in pregnancy, postpartum hemorrhage, operative vaginal birth, etc.).
